THE PASTOR'S PORTICO

This coming week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. It was first celebrated in the fourth or fifth century. This feast celebrates the coming of the Angel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin Mary to announce to her the special mission God had chosen for her in being the mother of His only son. From all eternity, God destined her to be the mother of Jesus and closely related to him in the creation and redemption of the world. But does this mean it was forced upon her? Absolutely not! In fact, St. Bernard of Clairvaux said in a homily that all of creation awaited her response, *"The angel awaits an answer; it is time for him to return to God who sent him. We too are waiting, O Lady, for your word of compassion... The price of our salvation is offered to you. We shall be set free at once if you consent."* Of course, we know that Mary did consent saying, *"Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word."* Her one yes changed the world!

In order to mark this feast (Friday, March 25th) as a parish, I would ask that you prayerfully consider taking an hour at the Niagara Falls General Hospital, where we can witness and pray for the sanctity of human life. The vigil runs from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. There is free parking at St. Ann's Adult Education Centre (5895 North Street). Signs are located at 6111 North Street. Also, please consider joining Bishop Bergie at the Cathedral for the Respect Life Mass that evening at 7:00 p.m.

I encourage you continue to pray for a peaceful resolution to the conflict in Ukraine. If you would like to make a financial contribution, you can do so through the parish. Cheques should be made payable to the parish clearly marked "Ukraine Relief" and funds collected will then be forwarded to the Chancery office. The Chancery office will send all monetary donations to the Catholic Near East Welfare Association. You can also donate online through the website cnewa.org/ca/donate. St. John the Theologian Ukrainian Catholic Church (91 Lakeshore Road, St. Catharines) is also collecting essential supplies to send to Ukraine. PARISH BIBLE STUDY

Looking for an amazing Bible Study to enhance your understanding of Sacred Scripture? Well, you are in luck. St. Denis has partnered with Branches Catholic Ministries to present Jeff Cavins' popular video series, "*The Great Adventure: A Journey through the Bible.*" This exciting study will take your understanding of Sacred Scripture and your Catholic faith to entirely new levels:

- Understand how the people, places and events of the Bible fit together in God's plan of salvation history and how relevant this is to our lives today.
- Learn the six covenants God made with humanity and how they led to the establishment of the Catholic Church.

The study is 24 weeks long, broken into two 12-week sessions (Spring & Fall). The first session will be offered twice per week:

Thursday Evenings: 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
(Starting weekly on Thursday, March 24)

All studies will be held in the parish hall and the second 12-week session will take place starting in September. The only cost is for the student workbook which is \$42.00 (tax included); this will be purchased at the first study session. All forms of payment accepted (cash, debit, credit). There will only be 60 spots available.
